



Scholarship Policy for Jamia Nadwiyya Women's Arabic College, Edavanna

1. Introduction

Jamia Nadwiyya Women's Arabic College (JNWAC) is committed to encouraging academic achievement and inclusivity by offering financial support to deserving students. This policy details the range of scholarships available at the college, including those funded by the Jamia Nadwiyya Trust and PTA, to assist students in their educational pursuits.

2. A.P Abdul Khader Moulavi Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Open to all students enrolled in courses offered by JNWAC.

Funding Source: Jamia Nadwiyya Trust

Amount: Full tuition fee waiver for the duration of the course.

Application Process: Each and every students enrolled in courses offered by JNWAC are considered for the scholarship along with their admission.

3. Haleema Beevi Memorial Scholarship

Eligibility: Hostel students enrolled in courses offered by JNWAC.

Funding Source: Jamia Nadwiyya Trust

Amount: Full hostel fee waiver for the duration of the course.

Application Process: Each and every hostel students enrolled in courses offered by JNWAC are considered for the scholarship along with their admission.

4. Al-Janah Educational Grant

Eligibility: economically disadvantaged students enrolled in courses offered by JNWAC.

Funding Source: JNWAC Students Union

Amount: Amount will vary based on the financial needs of the applicants and the availability of funds.

Application Process: JNWAC Students Union will notify the students about the grant and collect personal statement of the applicants about their financial status. The students union verifies and provide the grant to eligible students.



5. General Eligibility Criteria

Enrolment: Applicants must be enrolled in or have received an offer of admission to a full-time program at JNWAC.

Academic Performance: Applicants must maintain a satisfactory academic record in accordance with the college's standards.

Conduct: Applicants must comply with the college's code of conduct.

Performance Review: The renewal of scholarships may depend on periodic performance reviews.
