This policy applies to all students, staff, and stakeholders who utilize e-governance tools and services at JNAC.

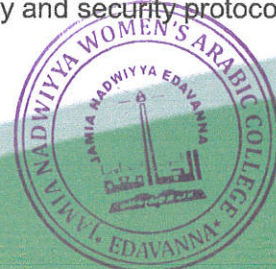
4. Definitions

5. Responsibilities

- **Management:** The administration of JNAC is responsible for overseeing the ethical, effective, and responsible use of e-governance tools and services.
- **Users:** All students, staff, and stakeholders are responsible for ensuring the protection of personal information and adhering to privacy and security protocols.
