



Green Protocol Policy

Jamia Nadwiyya Women's Arabic College is committed to maintaining a clean and sustainable campus by promoting environmentally friendly practices among students and staff. Our goal is to foster eco-consciousness within the college community and beyond, creating a campus where ecological sustainability and education are intertwined to support eco-friendly initiatives.

In alignment with the Green Campus Protocol advocated by the Government of Kerala and the Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, the college implements the following guidelines and initiatives to enhance environmental sustainability:

Energy Conservation

- Promote energy conservation by encouraging the use of energy-efficient practices and devices.
- Install and utilize energy-efficient products, such as star-labeled CFLs and LEDs.
- Activate power management features on computers, monitors, and printers to reduce energy consumption. Turn off equipment and lights when not in use.

Reduction of Disposable Items

- Minimize the use of disposable items during college functions and meetings.
- Encourage the use of reusable alternatives whenever possible.

Promotion of Digital Documents

- Promote the use of electronic documents and encourage double-sided printing to reduce paper usage.

Promotion of Non-Motorized Transport

- Restrict automobile access on campus and establish pedestrian-friendly pathways to encourage walking and cycling.

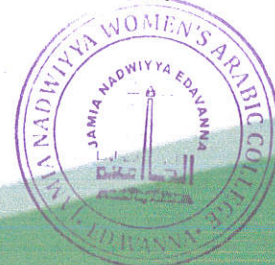
Vegetable and Herbal Gardening

Tree Plantation

- Plant trees on significant occasions to enhance the greenery of the campus.

Use of Solar Energy

- Install solar-powered devices, such as solar lights, to reduce dependence on conventional energy sources.

Sustainable Stationery

- Encourage the use of eco-friendly stationery, such as biodegradable pens and electronic display boards, in place of paper and plastic materials.

Solid Waste Management

- Implement a comprehensive waste management system with segregated collection using color-coded bins:
 - **Green:** Wet waste (degradable/organic)
 - **Blue:** Dry recyclable waste (plastic, aluminum foil, bottles, cans, etc.)

Energy-Saving Tips

- Activate power management features on computers and monitors to enter low-power "sleep" mode when not in use.
- Turn off monitors and unnecessary lights when leaving the workstation.
- Use fans only when needed and avoid decorative lighting.
- Utilize daylight whenever possible and keep lights off in unoccupied classrooms.

Plastic Reduction Policy

- Reduce the use of single-use plastics in all college functions and celebrations.
- Conduct awareness campaigns and workshops on the harmful impacts of single-use plastics.
- Encourage students to advocate for plastic reduction within their communities.
- Mandate faculty, staff, and students to avoid plastic bottles and use alternatives like paper bags and cloth bags.
