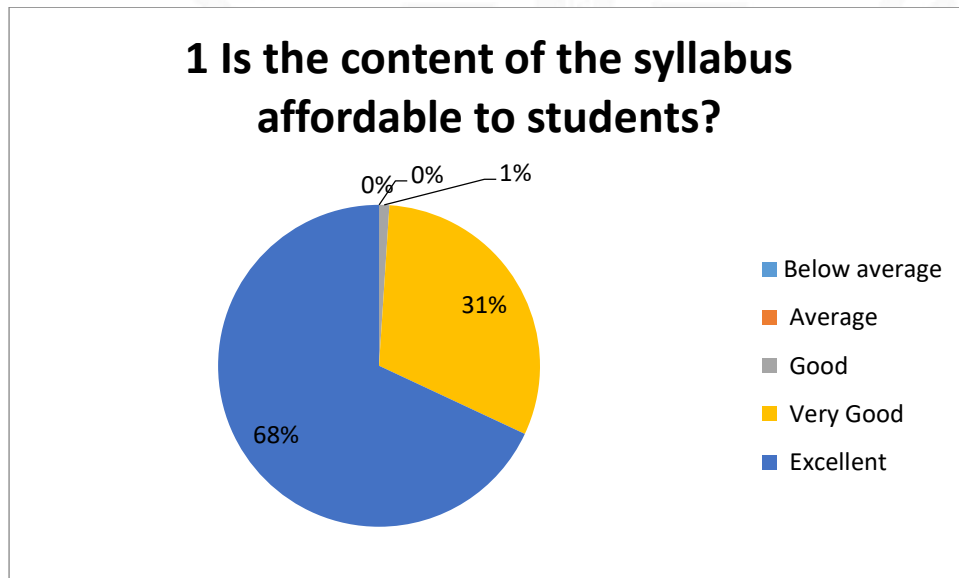

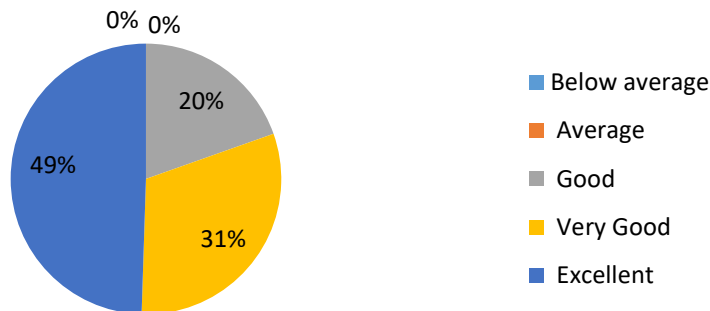

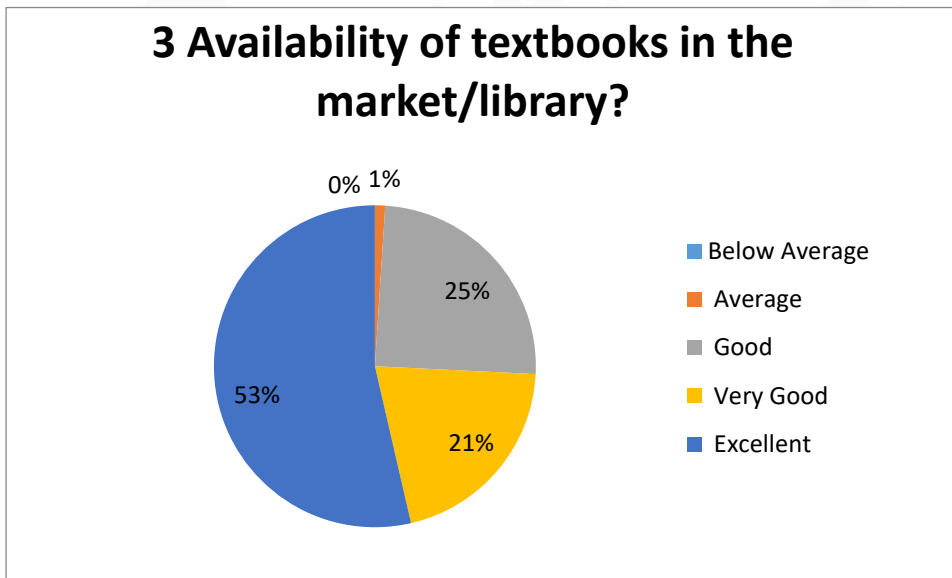

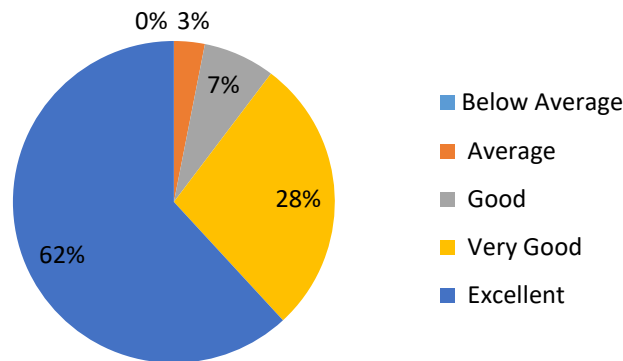

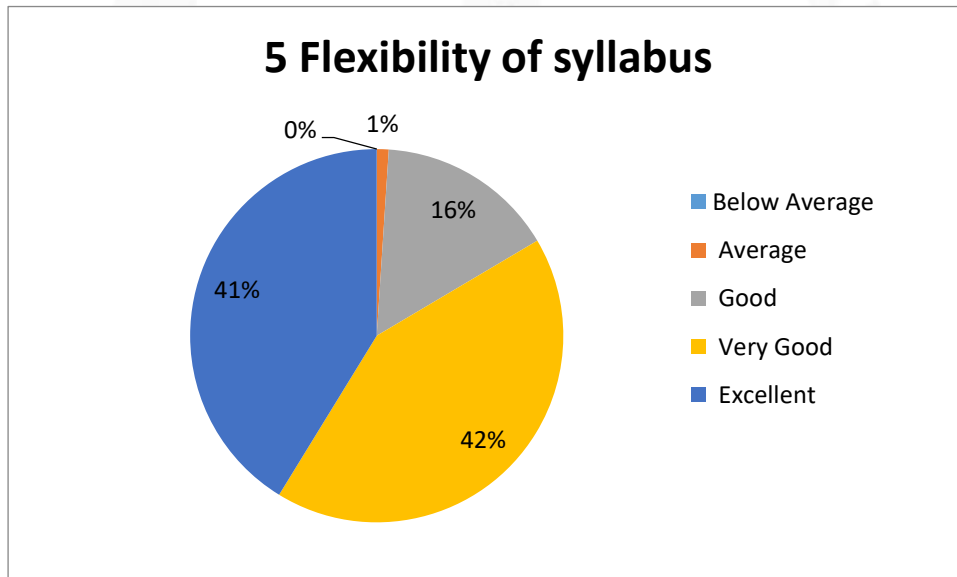

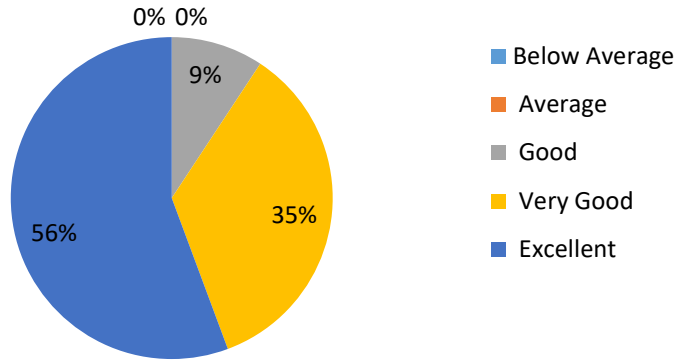

### **2018-19**

The feedback highlighted the need for updating curriculum content to better reflect current industry trends and the evolving needs of students. In response, we conducted a thorough review of the existing curriculum and collaborated with subject matter experts to integrate relevant advancements and contemporary topics. This update ensures that the curriculum remains both current and engaging for students.

Additionally, stakeholders emphasized the importance of diversifying teaching methods and resources. To address this, we introduced a variety of new digital tools and interactive resources designed to enhance instructional methods and support different learning styles. These resources aim to make lessons more engaging and effective, providing teachers with innovative approaches to deliver content.

Concerns were also raised about the effectiveness of our assessment methods. In response, we revised our assessment framework to include a balanced mix of formative and summative assessments. This change is intended to better evaluate student understanding and performance, with a particular focus on critical thinking and problem-solving skills.

Furthermore, feedback indicated a need for increased support and professional development for educators. To meet this need, we launched a comprehensive professional development program that includes workshops and training sessions focused on the new curriculum and advanced teaching strategies. This program is designed to empower teachers with the knowledge and skills required to implement the revised curriculum effectively.
