
#### METHODOLOGY














6. Proportionality of the syllabus to the number of hours available.











## ALUMNI FEEDBACK ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2020-21

Alumni feedback is an invaluable resource for enhancing educational programs and institutional practices. It provides insights from former students who have firsthand experience with the curriculum, training, and support services.

This feedback helps identify strengths and areas for improvement, ensuring that the institution's offerings remain relevant and effective. In response to the feedback provided by our alumni, we have undertaken several key actions to enhance our programs and support services. Alumni highlighted the need for stronger practical applications and career preparation within the curriculum.

In response, we have integrated more hands-on projects, internships, and real-world case studies into our courses. Additionally, alumni requested better networking opportunities and continued support post-graduation. To address this, we have established a dedicated alumni network that facilitates ongoing engagement and professional development through events, webinars, and mentorship programs.

Furthermore, feedback on the need for updated industry-relevant content led to curriculum revisions that incorporate current industry trends and technologies. These changes have been implemented to ensure our programs remain relevant and provide our graduates with the skills and support necessary for continued success in their careers.

Consider reducing reliance on expensive textbooks by recommending free online resources or open-source materials.	The syllabus was revised to include more affordable resources, and a list of open educational resources (OER) was provided to students.
Provide clear guidelines on essential reading versus supplementary reading to reduce the burden on students.	Professors highlighted key readings and optional materials, ensuring that students are not overwhelmed with extra reading beyond the core syllabus.
Introduce elective options or modular structures that allow students to choose topics of interest.	Elective courses were introduced in the syllabus, giving students flexibility to tailor their learning according to their career goals.
Ensure that the subjects include practical applications and real-world examples.	Practical sessions, case studies, and internships were integrated into the syllabus to enhance practical understanding of the subjects.

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## STUDENTS FEEDBACK ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2020-21

The feedback revealed several critical areas needing improvement. Specifically, students expressed a desire for more engaging and interactive teaching methods, reported dissatisfaction with the condition of campus facilities, experienced delays in administrative processes, and requested enhanced support services.

This report outlines the actions taken in response to student feedback, detailing the specific areas of concern raised, the measures implemented to address these issues, and the subsequent outcomes. It serves to document how student input has been integrated into institutional practices to enhance the overall educational experience, ensuring transparency and accountability in the process.

In response, we implemented several targeted actions: we revamped the curriculum to incorporate more interactive teaching techniques and group activities, upgraded the library's furniture and lighting to create a more conducive study environment, streamlined administrative procedures to expedite processing times, and expanded our career counseling services by adding additional appointment slots and new workshops.

These measures have already led to noticeable improvements in student engagement and satisfaction. The upgraded facilities and enhanced support services have been particularly well-received, with students reporting a more positive and supportive campus experience. Looking ahead, we are committed to addressing any ongoing issues and will continue to seek and act on student feedback to foster an environment of continuous improvement and support.

## TEACHERS FEEDBACK ACTION TAKEN REPORT 2020-21

In response to the feedback received from teachers, this report outlines the actions taken to address their concerns and evaluates the outcomes. The feedback was collected through surveys and meetings, highlighting several key areas for improvement: curriculum updates, classroom resources, and administrative support.

Regarding the curriculum, teachers noted the need for updated materials and more diverse resources. In response, the curriculum was revised to include new and relevant content, and additional resources were procured. This update has been positively received, though ongoing evaluation will ensure it continues to meet teachers' needs.

Teachers also expressed concerns about inadequate classroom resources, such as outdated technology and insufficient supplies. To address this, new equipment was purchased and the supply budget was increased. Initial feedback indicates an improvement in classroom functionality, but we will continue to monitor resource levels to address any further needs.

Administrative support was another area of concern, with feedback focusing on communication issues and the need for more support staff. Measures taken include enhancing communication channels and hiring additional administrative personnel. These actions have led to better support for teachers, although we remain attentive to any remaining challenges.

Overall, the actions taken have led to noticeable improvements, but we acknowledge that some issues persist. We will continue to gather feedback and make adjustments as necessary to ensure ongoing progress and support for our teaching staff. Future steps will involve further refinements based on continuous feedback and monitoring.






