





















Communication with parents has been improved through regular updates and feedback channels to ensure better collaboration. These actions were initiated promptly and are being monitored through regular assessments to evaluate their effectiveness and make further adjustments if necessary. The overall goal is to continuously refine teaching practices and improve the educational experience for all students.
